

Directions to Heatree Activity Centre



From the M5 (Southbound)

At Junction 31 the M5 becomes the A38 (Devon Expressway), continue on the A38 towards Plymouth (NOT A380 Torquay).

From the A30

At the end of the A30, join the A38 (Devon Expressway) (NOT M5 North), continue on the A38 towards Plymouth (NOT A380 Torquay).

Exiting the A38

Exit the A38 at the A382, signposted to Newton Abbot/Bovey Tracey. Follow the A382 towards Bovey Tracey, (4th exit off the roundabout) and go straight across the next roundabout, signposted Town Centre/Moretonhampstead. At the next small roundabout (granite sculpture in the centre), turn left, signposted Haytor. **See separate routes for cars and coaches below – coaches DO NOT use the car route.**

For car drivers

A few hundred yards after leaving Bovey Tracey later take the right fork, signposted Manaton (parts of this road are narrow). Continue on this road for approximately 4 miles until you pass Becky Falls and enter Manaton. Continue past the Kestor Inn on your right and go straight on, passing the Parish Church on your right. Follow the twisting lane for a further 3-4 miles, following signs for Hound Tor. At the crossroads (Heatree Cross) you will see a grit box, a postbox and Heatree Lodge cottage. Continue straight on and in 300 hundred yards turn left up the drive at the large stone sign for Heatree Activity Centre.

For coach drivers

Follow the Haytor route shown on the map below.
